Six of us returned from our Cameroon Mission trip tired, fulfilled and thankful to God for a very adventurous experience. We traveled many kilometers by air, bus, Toyota Helix & on foot.



Prior to this I was team teaching with Pastor Efraim del Rasario in Rostov Don. Twenty-three Russian students are anxious to prepare for pastoral ministry. Dr. Sig Schuster reports that 85% of the men and women trained go into full time ministry. PTL

In Amsterdam I met the team of six, then flew via Nairobi to Douala, Cameroon.


Our purpose was to help Cameroonians build four church roofs. The location was in the N W interior of the country, near the Nigerian Border. After two days of travel in a Toyota Hilex, we arrived at Andre, Kom, Lus and Mashi. The further north we traveled the worse the road conditions were til there were no roads.



It was amazing to see the men carrying cement bags 10 kl to the building site. Lumber was cut in the hills with 36" chainsaws and a chalk line.. The women carried the boards down to the church site. Children were involved carrying water, sand and stones from the River. Two churches were totally finished at our departure and two needed more material to finish.

6,300 persons viewed the Jesus Film and 356 adults responded positively to the

invitation. The results were incredible. Some Chiefs and Leaders of the community also became Christians.



At Kolah Pastor Eric Spletzer and I baptized 28 new believers in the Dongo River. In that community a new church was begun.



Ben Martin and Evangelist Robertson trekked for three hours to a remote community called Beni. And through the Jesus Film many believers asked to have a new church established. Now a community of about 500 has a church with a pastor to teach the new Christians. A lady very excitedly said: “I am a Christian now, there is a church for my children, I have seen a white man and now I can die.” WHOW!

Thank you for your prayers and financial support. Without your help and prayers nothing would have happened.
